

What is Main Slides?

Main Slides is the section in the CMS panel used to manage the banner images displayed across the website.

When a banner image is uploaded and submitted here, it will automatically appear on:

- The Home Page
- The selected Landing Page (Division/Range Page)
- The selected Molecule Page (specific molecule as selected)

There is no need to update banners separately on each page. A single upload in the Main Slides section will automatically update all the selected pages.

Note 1:

If a new banner is added with Order Number 1, the existing banners will automatically adjust their order numbers accordingly.

Note 2 :

After uploading a banner, all details such as Order Number, Landing Page, and Molecule Page can be edited anytime. Scroll down on the same page to view the complete banner list, where **Edit** and **Delete** options are available for each banner.
